EXTRA MONEY

1. MEALS

TOUR RULES

1. Be on time for ALL Call Times.
2. ALWAYS TRAVEL IN GROUPS OF 3 OR MORE AT ALL TIMES! NO ONE TRAVELS ALONE!!!!
3. Students must stay with assigned chaperones when outside of the hotel AT ALL TIMES.
4. The FALCON DRESS CODE is in effect.
 - I. Clothing or articles of clothing or jewelry, which may provoke others to acts of violence or be used as weapons including by not limited to wristbands, oversized belts, belt buckles, chains, and any other gang identified items are prohibited.
 - II. Belt buckles with any letters or initials are prohibited.
 - III. Pants must fit properly at the waist. Saggy pants, cut-offs to the knee, and/or split pants are not permitted. Excessively long shirts, oversized pants, and long socks are also prohibited.
 - IV. Clothing and jewelry will be free of writing, pictures, and any other insignia or indications which are profane, obscene, sexually suggestive, or which advocate racial, ethnic or religious prejudice, tagging, gambling, violence, the use of drugs or alcohol, or any other illegal or unsafe activity.
 - V. Non-Duarte High School hats are OKAY, but cannot be vulgar or gang affiliated.
 - VI. Shoes must be worn at all times, unless you are in your room.
 - VII. Plain white t-shirts are prohibited.
 - VIII. Clothing will not be provocative and will be sufficient to conceal undergarments at all times. See-through or fishnet fabrics, tube tops, and bare midriffs are prohibited.
5. "In-Room" and "Lights Out" times are to be heeded.
6. Do not congregate in the hallways of the hotels. Do not run!
7. There will be NO members of the opposite gender in hotel rooms without the door open
8. Inappropriate sexual behavior will NOT be tolerated. *Actions like such will result in removal from the Tour, at the student's family expense.*
9. Lying, stealing or vandalism will NOT be tolerated. *Actions like such will result in removal from the Tour, at the student's family expense.*
10. NO DRUGS OR ALCOHOL. *Possession of such will result in removal from the Tour, at the student's family expense.*
